Deadline for Nominations	Winter term: 15 th May Summer term: 15 th November
Deadline for Application Forms	Winter term: 15 th June Summer term: 15 th December

Application procedure	After the nomination period has ended, nominated students will receive the application form as a pdf-file and a link to the online-registration via email. Students need to print out and complete the application form, have it signed and stamped by their home university and send it via ordinary mail, and to complete the online registration.
After the application	The official Letter of Admission and an information brochure will be sent to the students via ordinary mail. The Letter of Admission needs to be presented upon enrolment.
Language requirements	We do NOT require any official certificates even though the majority of modules is taught in German.
	In the interest of your students, however, please make sure you <u>only</u> nominate students who are sufficiently proficient in German in order to be able to successfully cope with academic work (language level B1, <u>Medicine: B2</u>).
	Should you wish to nominate a strong student who does not speak German, please make sure they speak English to at least a B2 standard.
	Other language requirements: English language skills may be required for the Master Molecular Biosciences; Japanese language skills for the Master of Japanese Studies, etc.
Language Courses	In order to help adjusting to life at a German university and to brush up on language skills, Erasmus students may take part in an intensive four-week language course before the semester begins, as well as weekly courses during the semester.
	These courses are non-obligatory and need to be paid by students themselves. Places are limited, especially in the winter semester.
Accommodation	A room in a student hall is not included in the exchange!
	As the number of rooms in student halls is very limited, we strongly recommend students look for accommodation on the private market in in addition to their application for halls.
Additional costs	Every student at the University of Heidelberg pays a social service fee of € 66,50per semester as part of the enrolment process to support social offers of the Students Union (internet café, psycho-social counselling etc.).
