c. Advocacy

We are looking for alliances with politicians and political parties at different geographical levels and expect to be involved in lobbying for change with reform of the existing rights of mobile EU citizens to vote and stand in local and European elections already on the agenda. You should be a natural citizen lobbyist and campaigner.

d. Communication

We have mapped Facebook groups and need now to create more social media posts in different languages and get the ECI mentioned in mainstream media! We are looking for content-creative souls to produce visuals, podcasts or catchy slogans, write short articles and come up with ideas! (

We are looking for a network of young people with not just all these skills in theory but also the ability to put them to use and persuade people to sign the ECI.
