4	= ausreichend <i>sufficient, passed</i>
5	= nicht ausreichend <i>deficient (fail)</i>
unbenoteter Schein	= pass <i>(P)</i>
Teilnahmeschein	= certificate of attendance <i>(CA)</i>

Please note that this grading system may slightly differ in the departments.
